Renaissance High School open its doors in 1978 on the former site of Catholic Central High School. The First Graduating class was in 1981. The story of Renaissance has been one of Detroit leading college preparatory schools in the city over the last 40 years. A school that benefited from great early administrative and student leadership and accomplishments that propelled the city council to approve a new building for the school was dedicated in 2005 at the site of the former Sinai Hospital. Renaissance High School has transformed historically from an intimate graduation of 100-150 students at a 99% graduation rate through the 1990's and early 2000's to over 800-1130 students a year graduating with a 98% graduation rate.

Within the last 40 years, Detroit Renaissance High School has celebrated State and City Awards for Education and Sports, and the Arts. A school that is anchored with a rich history of principals that have kept the level of excellence for decades.
